

Information for Visitors

Below you will find some information for the visitors to our Institute.

The campus of [Poznan University of Technology \(PUT\)](#) (Politechnika Poznańska) is situated on the bank of the Warta river, in the square of Piotrowo, Berdychowo, Jana Pawła II, and Kórnicka streets. The PUT campus is a walking distance from Malta lake and the Old Town.

To get to the campus from the [airport Poznań-Ławica](#), choose a taxi. We suggest that you should call one of the following taxi companies:

The journey will take approximately 20 min. during normal traffic conditions. Optionally, you can follow the airport directions to the city center:

If you arrive at Poznan Railway Station – Dworzec Główny, pick up trams No 5 or 13 heading for Stomil or Staroleka respectively. All timetables are available at tram stops. Tickets can be bought in vending machines located at the Railway Station.

You will find the English version which should make your life easier. Remember to enter POLITECHNIKA, Piotrowo as your destination or the hotel name and/or street if necessary.
